



i hate how i look, i don't put on weight and if i do i lose it so easily. just from vaping for a month and a half i lost 10 pounds


my mom sent me something and i feel like i don't deserve it. haven't even responded



this is what it is gonna sound like when it eventually releases on streaming, it's supposed to go up today but distrokid has been hit or miss when it comes to getting my music out on time. we also uploaded it yesterday so yeah. this leads me into the topic of today's blog:

the pursuit of perfection

i didn't really put out as much content as i would have liked to this year. i've been steady making stuff, but more than half of what i've made has been scrapped. i get so anal about the details in my work that i won't release anything that isn't perfect. if i release something rough, it's part of the joke. AVG JOES isn't perfect

and that's okay.

we shot the video for the livestream twice, preferably i would have liked to have done it once so i could maintain the illusion that it's happening live but neither of the shoots went according to plan. i could have done it 10 times that night if i needed to but when you're working with other people you need to compromise. the album as a whole was rushed, like we recorded verses 20 minutes before we filmed the video. i noticed some background noise in one of the verses today and considered taking the whole album down because of it. i've done that before with my own music more than once but the last 3 releases were a bit more calculated. my next one i'm planning out 3+ months in advance. hoping to learn from all of this.

there is another side of the coin though. i remember watching some video about why south park only limits themselves to a week per episode, and they said it's because overthinking something can complicate it and after a while you begin to doubt your initial ideas in favor of newer ones. they are right, but i feel overthinking is part of my nature. i don't want to limit myself through words because i genuinely see it as more of a strength than an advantage. i have a clear vision of what i want something to be like and i thank god for granting me internal inspiration.

my new years resolution is to set more deadlines so i can plan my projects more accordingly. prince told me something similar. that's why i'm coining it as the AVG JOE mindset.





candle making!

i post a lot about my other hobbies on this site, but i've never written about this one in particular.

this is something i do at least once a month, i burn them myself as well as give them give them out as gifts. this is something simple and rewarding that you can do in the background while you're working on something else, but it still requires attention (will elaborate later). all it requires is: 1. empty glass/metal jars; i've found that ones with the diameter of a toothpick work the best, in terms of burning evenly and giving enough room to light it once they burn down.

2. **toothpick**: you'll need one to hold up the wick while you are filling the basin with wax. like i mentioned, jars with that length are perfect for fitting your fat fingers in when they run low and you need to light that last bit.

3. **candle wax**: i recycle all my old candles, but i also use wax melts from dollar tree or walmart. the cheapest candles you can find are usually those tall white prayer candles, and while those don't have much of a scent i add essential oils to give it some flavor.

4. **hemp wick**; i've used many different kinds of wicks but i've found that this works the best. you can buy designated cotton wicks online but they're typically uniform in size, which doesn't work for the variety of glass jars i've collected. you can cut hemp wick into the size you need, and i've found that it burns slower than the alternatives. also weed Imao

5. **pan/stove**: this is where you make the candles. i recommend using a cheap pan or one you don't care about anymore because the wax is hard to remove once it dries. you will need to fill up the pan with water or the glass shatters from the heat of the pan. science rules

so basically you're gonna fill up the pan with water, place your old candles in the basin to melt the wax, then set up your empty jars like the image above. i recommend pouring only a little bit in first and letting it solidify so the wick is anchored at the bottom. finally, you just wait for the wax to melt then fill those bad boys up to the top. voila, you have a candle!

so, why candles? i first picked up this hobby because my cat used to piss everywhere and my apartment stank. i got him neutered, so that problem was resolved but i also found that the candles i make also mask the smell of the dank shit i smoke, so i continued to make them. in a way, my candles tell a story because as soon is one is done, i melt it into the next one. the same way that you carry genes of your ancestors, there is a little bit of that first candle i made in every single one i produce.


i must issue a disclaimer, this can be dangerous if not done properly. i recommend staying in the kitchen while you're melting and consistently refilling the water in the pan. if not, <u>this</u> will happen. yes, that was me, and admittedly, i was playing fortnite and forgot i was making candles. luckily, i had renters insurance, but it was still traumatic, so don't be like me, don't leave something burning on the stove unattended. feels like that goes without saying but i had to learn it the hard way, if you let the water run out the glass will shatter, and the wax will catch fire.

i know that last part might be discouraging but it didn't stop me. i just learned my lesson, brushed off my shoulders and kept on truckin. the fact that i continue to do this is a testament of resilience, if i let that stop me i would have let a lot of other things stop me from living my life the way i should. at the end of the day, this is a fulfilling hobby and makes gift-giving easier once that time of year comes around. if you value patience, good smells and handmade craft then this might be for you too. thanks for reading :)



who is s366?

the answer is a bit more complicated than just "my stage name" which is the easy explanation. s366 is me, but i am not s366. s366 is a code, i chose the name because it sounded like a file extension or something you would punch in at the self checkout to buy produce. it sounded dystopian, imagining a world where everyone's names were reduced to a 4 digit code.

but why that letter and those numbers? i've had a lot of online pseudonyms over the years. sometime around fall 2016 i made an inst*gr*m account called

"s3e6a5n." it was my guv'mint name but with my last name turning into 365, meaning every day, daily. this went on for a bit, when i started posting music i posted it under the s3e6a5n name. i spent YEARS on my first project only to post it my first week of college without any of the verses i recorded because i didn't like how i sounded. i was also recording in audacity with stock plugins so there wasn't as much to work with. this one was called *singles only*, which was accompanied by other singles dropped weeks prior that i decided not to include in the album.

sometime in the next year i shortened it to s365, because saying the prior name out loud was too long. i made an ep over the summer in europe and released my first "real" project, every day on october first. i say first real project because that's the first one where i recorded my voice extensively. i was guite proud of it when it came out and still look back upon it fondly. i wanted to make it clear that i was just having fun and not taking it too seriously, but i was. i remember my roomate said i was addicted to making music. i got inspiration from general dissatisfaction with my life, i hated college, i lived in the laundry room of our apartment, and was going back and forth between periods of heavy drug use and sobriety. the name, every day is kind of a self title, because 365 means every day. i also imagined saying it in a frustrated manner, like "every day i gotta put up with this bullshit!" i remember like 3 days before i was supposed to post the album i had my laptop in my backpack walking to class, then it rained, laptop fried, and i got it repaired but had to delay the album. that's the kind of mood i was going for. in early 2020 i changed my name to s366. my soundcloud was about to fill up, and i told myself that the next one i made would be called s366. i started to like that name more because i was born on a leap year and it rolled off the tongue better than 365. instead of making a new account, i purchased the soundcloud pro plan where i could have unlimited uploads and changed my

name to s366, which it has remained for the last 4 years. the first project i released under that name was second winter, which took the foundation i laid in every day and amplified it with a cavalcade of features from my friends and even more distortion. it was intended to be a continuation of the themes in my first project, with the initial idea being them packaged together as a double album called "every day is second winter." eventually, time passed and i found myself in another chapter of my life so i published them as separate projects. my next album, *music for the mental*, was my first that i made in logic pro if you don't count *cc:nh* which was a group effort although i was the one hosting all the files and "mixing" it. i didn't really know what i was really doing but it helped me learn the ropes, and it was an easy transition as i made the last 2 projects on garageband. i released this project in summer 2020, what a time to be alive. i'll go on record saying that i had the time of my life during covid, and this album was a reflection of that. even though i posted it in june i ended up perfecting it until the end of august and have both versions available on my bandcamp. it was really a product of it's time, and hasn't aged as well as some of my other albums in my opinion. with that being said, it brings me back to that time, which may have sucked for you but it was great for me. i released *feedback* in december of 2020, on the 366th day of the year. a few of the tracks i made while remastering the previous album but i wanted to focus more on making the verses good and relying less on features to carry the song. i wanted it to be much longer but i had the release date set for a while. once again, i changed a few things after the album released, but it was only a few days after the intial release date. t. roosevelt and imaginary friends are 2 of my favorite songs but the project is kind of all over the place so it's not my favorite. it's also the first time i collaborated with princeyy, who was added to the album last minute after it was initially released.

i didn't drop another full project until august of that year but i had released a few throwaways and gone through many iterations of what would become *phoenix*, the fourth/fifth s366 project. this one might be my favorite along with the latest album i released, it is just so consistent and came out of a very difficult time, like a phoenix rising from the ashes. it was also the first album i went to st. louis to master.


the next project i made, *transparency*, was released in march 2022. this album was intended to be more hopeful and lighthearted than the last, going back to not taking it that seriously. all of my albums have had sillier tracks but theres more upbeat ones than dark songs here, contrary to the previous few. this one is also kind of all over the place and while the intention was to be transparent, like hey, look at the real me, i don't think i really conveyed that.

two months later i released *eating order* with nebula, my first joint collab album we h ad been bouncing tracks between each other for a few years and one week while he visited me we finished up the album and posted it on my birthday, also the same day i graduated college. wow, time flies. i wouldn't release another album until the end of the year, but i had the cover in mind since before this. you might have noticed i haven't talked about the covers of my albums at all, i'm saving that for a future entry. this one is long enough. so yeah anyways i released *the loser aesthetic* on my brothers birthday that year. it originally had a different, more cringeworthy title that i want to forget about. it was a careless jumble of words, slashes and parentheses, making saying the name out loud more painful than saying "s3e6a5n." the new title is the same idea but better. i see this album as a transition into singing more than rapping on my songs, which is the direction i'd like to go in. i didn't release any albums under s366 for a whole year but princeyy and i made the first avg joes album during this time. i released /nightwalk/ on leap day this year, which you could also count as the 366th extra day. as i

mentioned earlier, this is my favorite project thus far, and an improvement over the same formula that has been evolving over the last 5 years. this was originally intended to be the final s366 album, as was the previous (tla), but i think i got one more in me. i wouldn't stop creating, i just think i have outgrown this name. just like the name of this website, people get confused when they hear it. it's not as memorable as a one syllable name that people describe as "easy to remember." but i like it that way, as my nature is to hang on the fringes of society, and with a name like that it's where i remain. i don't want to keep shooting myself in the foot though. i like the name infelicities, and have considered shortening it to "infel," but people say it sounds like incel or infidel, which again, puts me on the fringes of society but with a more extremist angle which is kind of cool if you're fucked in the head. whatever it may be, i will never stop making things. art is what makes life worth living and music brings memories back better than a picture can sometimes. i hope you enjoyed this lengthy biography about my bullshit life hope it provides some insight and have a nice day!
